


NRL SUPPORTS DONALD TRUMP FOR PRESIDENT

The Nebraska Right to Life Board of Directors met in June and voted to support Donald Trump in the race for the U.S. Presidency.

“We have a clear-cut decision in the Presidential race,” said Julie Schmit-Albin, Executive Director of Nebraska Right to Life. “The next President could be nominating from three to four U.S. Supreme Court Justices. As we have seen with the Court’s decision on the Texas abortion case, the ability of the pro-life movement to pass meaningful State restrictions is in jeopardy. Moreover, the demeanor of the Court has shifted with the death of Justice Antonin Scalia.

“We know what Planned Parenthood and NARAL friend Hillary Clinton will do to the Supreme Court. Donald

Trump on the other hand has already released a list of potential Supreme Court nominees which have passed scrutiny by two major conservative legal organizations. He has said he would defund the abortion industry, and is for the reversal of Roe v. Wade and returning the issue to the States. He has also reached out to faith-based leaders and pro-life, pro-family organizations to begin a dialogue regarding pro-life issues.

“Nebraska Right to Life will be



distributing thousands of fliers at County Fairs and our State Fair booth, showing the stark contrast between Clinton and Trump on abortion. The stakes have never been higher. We must elect a pro-life President and keep Hillary Clinton out of the White House.”

NRLC RESPONDS TO SUPREME COURT DECISION IN WHOLE WOMAN’S HEALTH V. HELLERSTEDT

By a vote of 5-3 June 27th, the U.S. Supreme Court struck provisions of a Texas law requiring abortion clinics to meet the same standards as ambulatory surgical centers and requiring abortionists to have admitting privileges at a nearby hospital in case of medical emergencies (with certain exceptions). The Fifth Circuit U.S. Court of Appeals previously rejected facial attacks on both provisions.

“How shabby are these abortion clinics that they cannot meet the minimum standards other outpatient surgical centers are required to meet, and just how bad are these abortionists that they can’t get admitting privileges at a local hospital?” said Carol Tobias, National Right to Life President. “As we saw with Kermit Gosnell in Philadelphia, it’s clear that the lucrative abortion industry is not able or willing to police itself and allows filthy, deplorable conditions to go unchecked.”

The provisions struck by the Court were part of a broader

pro-life omnibus package passed by the Texas legislature in 2013. Texas HB2 also included National Right to Life model language to protect unborn children who are capable of experiencing great pain when being killed by dismemberment or other late-abortion methods. An unborn child is capable of feeling pain by 20 weeks after fertilization and earlier. That provision of the law was unchallenged in *Whole Woman’s Health v. Hellerstedt*.

“In the years following *Roe v. Wade*, the Court exhibited extreme hostility to regulation of abortion as a medical procedure,” said Tobias. “However, in its 1992 *Casey* decision, the Court turned a corner, rejecting the idea of it being ‘the country’s ex officio medical board.’ Today, they reversed course and decided that they know better than representatives duly elected by the people of the United States.”

PRO-LIFE INDIANA GOV. MIKE PENCE IS 'EXCELLENT CHOICE' FOR VICE PRESIDENT

The president of the National Right to Life Committee (NRLC), the federation of state right-to-life affiliates, said that pro-life Indiana Gov. Mike Pence is an "excellent choice" for vice president by Republican nominee Donald J. Trump. Trump announced Pence as his running mate via Twitter July 15th.

"With a solid pro-life voting record on abortion during his time in Congress, and through his pro-life actions as Indiana governor, Mike Pence has proven himself to be a strong leader for the right to life," said Carol Tobias, NRLC President.

During his tenure in the U.S. House of Representatives from 2001 to 2012, Pence served as a member of the House Judiciary Committee and on the Subcommittee on the Constitution. In those positions, he actively participated in hearings and committee action on a number of major pro-life bills, including the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act, enacted

in 2003, and the Unborn Victims of Violence Act, enacted in 2004. National Right to Life scorecards for those years are accessible via our Legislative Action Center.

As Indiana governor, Pence has championed several pro-life measures, including most recently a bill that, among other things, would ban abortionists from knowingly aborting an unborn baby solely because of a disability or because of the baby's race or gender. It is currently enjoined pending litigation.

"Mike Pence brings a strong pro-life background to the Republican ticket, which contrasts with the extreme pro-abortion position of Hillary Clinton and the Democrats," said Tobias.

CLINTON CHOOSES PRO-ABORTION SEN. TIM KAINE AS RUNNING MATE

The president of the National Right to Life Committee (NRLC), the federation of state right-to-life affiliates, said she is not surprised by presumptive Democrat nominee Hillary Clinton's choice of pro-abortion Senator Tim Kaine as her running mate.

"Like Hillary Clinton, Sen. Tim Kaine supports the current policy of abortion on demand," said Carol Tobias, NRLC President. "Like Hillary Clinton, Sen. Kaine is so extreme on abortion he opposes even the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act, legislation to protect unborn children from abortion after

20 weeks, when they are capable of feeling excruciating pain during dismemberment or other late-abortion methods."

As a U.S. Senator, Kaine has voted against the pro-life position every chance he got. He voted to allow government funding of abortion providers and voted against legislation to require an abortionist to notify at least one parent before performing an abortion on a minor girl from another state.

Kaine took his most extreme pro-abortion action yet with his recent co-sponsorship of the so-called Women's Health Protection Act (S.217), known

to pro-lifers as the "Abortion Without Limits Until Birth Act." This bill would nullify nearly all existing state and federal limitations on regulation of abortion and prohibit states from enacting meaningful pro-life laws in the future. This revamped version of the long-stalled "Freedom of Choice Act" is a priority of the pro-abortion forces in Washington, D.C.

"Sen. Kaine is good at hiding behind his Catholic background — but no one should be fooled," Tobias said. "His record, and his openly declared legislative goals, are as pro-abortion as they come."

ALL CHARGES DISMISSED AGAINST CENTE

The Harris County District Attorney's office dismissed all charges against anti-abortion activists who secretly videotaped Planned Parenthood officials in Houston July 26.

David Robert Daleiden and Sandra Merritt were charged with tampering with a governmental record for using a fake identification to gain access to the facility. In a surprise move before a hearing on the legitimacy of the indictment, prosecutors dismissed the charges.

Daleiden and his attorneys claimed victory for the anti-abortion movement, saying they were satisfied with the decision.

Daleiden, 27, and Sandra Merritt, 62, both of Davis, California, were indicted by a Harris County grand jury in January, accused of tampering with a government record for allegedly using fake driver licenses to conceal their identities while dealing with a Houston Planned Parenthood clinic.

"The dismissal of the bogus, politically motivated charges ... is a resounding vindication of the First Amendment rights of all citizen journalists, and also a clear warning to any of Planned Parenthood's political cronies who would attack whistleblowers to protect Planned Parenthood from scrutiny," Daleiden said in a statement. "Planned Parenthood tried to collude with public
