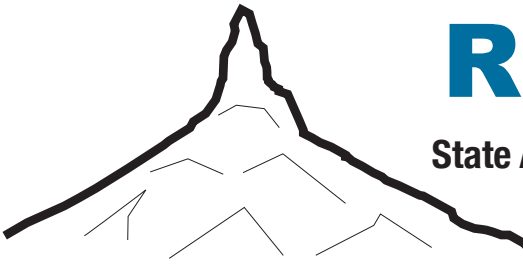

## GOVERNOR'S PRO-LIFE BUDGET LANGUAGE ON TITLE X FUNDING PASSES

The Nebraska Legislature passed LB 944, the mainline budget bill with Governor Pete Ricketts' pro-life language regarding Title X funding. Title X federal dollars pay for low-income health care needs such as wellness checks, cancer and STD screenings. The pro-life language specifies that entities that perform or refer for abortions must keep their Title X services physically, legally and financially separate from any abortion "services."

"This is the first time in seven years that the Legislature has passed pro-life legislation that will have a direct impact on the abortion industry," said Julie Schmit-Albin at the Governor's Bill Signing Ceremony. "We are thankful to Governor Ricketts for his efforts to return Nebraska to a State that leads in significant pro-life legislation, and we look forward to working with him on more pro-life efforts in the future."

## PRO-LIFE LEGISLATIVE DAY HELD MARCH 13TH

Nebraska Right to Life sponsored Pro-Life Legislative Day on March 13th, the first day LB 944 was heard on the legislative floor. Sixty pro-lifers were greeted that morning at

the State Capitol with rolls and coffee and a briefing of LB 944. Governor Pete Ricketts spoke to the activists and Senator Lou Ann Linehan, LD 39, who sponsored our meeting room, made an appearance.

After the briefing, pro-lifers proceeded to the Capitol Rotunda to call their Senators off the floor to discuss the pro-life provisions in LB 944. Planned Parenthood of the Heartland attempted to crowd the Rotunda with its supporters holding

# NEBRASKA RIGHT TO LIFE & LOCAL CHAPTERS BRING CANADIAN ANTI-EUTHANASIA LEADER TO STATE FOR TOUR

Nebraska Right to Life, Columbus Right to Life and South Central Nebraska Right to Life (Hastings area) brought Alex Schadenberg, Director of the Euthanasia Prevention Coalition of Ontario, Canada, to Nebraska March 18-20 for several speaking engagements.

On March 18th, Alex spoke at the South Central NE RTL Dinner in Hastings to over 110 people. On March 19th, he spoke at Columbus Right to Life to 80 people. On March 20th, NRL brought Alex to the State Capitol, where Senator Mike Hilgers, LD 21, got him introduced on the legislative floor. We then hosted lunch with Alex and pro-life pro-family lobbyists and Lt. Governor Mike Foley.

Alex then went to St. Gregory the Great Seminary in Seward to speak to about 25 Seminarians. That night he concluded his tour speaking to a small group of pro-lifers in Lincoln.

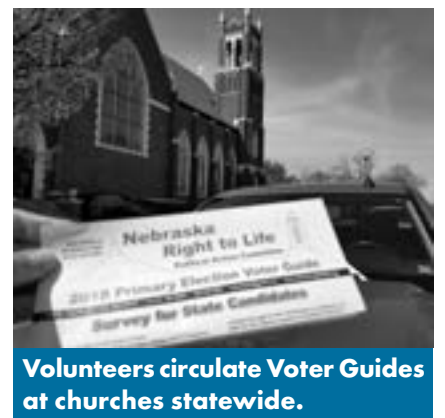
