

Mike Flood is a hero for the pro-life movement.

**As the lead sponsor of the landmark Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act,
he significantly advanced the entire pro-life movement.**

In 2010, The Pain-Cable Unborn Child Protection Act was introduced by then Speaker of the Legislature Mike Flood. After making LB1103 his priority bill, this first in the nation legislation passed with 44 votes providing protection for preborn babies at 20 weeks based on when they can feel pain.

As of today, 24 states have passed similar laws.



"In 2010, as speaker of Legislature, I introduced and helped pass the Abortion Pain Prevention Act, then the most sweeping pro-life law in the nation. It outlawed almost all abortions past the first 20 weeks of pregnancy and was the nation's first pro-life protection based on the science of fetal pain. ... It is my hope, and the hope of millions of Americans, that very soon, the people's ability to implement their will on this issue will no longer be constrained by arbitrary decisions made on the basis of arbitrary, fictitious readings of the Constitution."
